

Leave a Gift in Your Will

How to leave a gift in your will



Creating a charitable legacy through your will is an incredibly meaningful way to express your values and continue to support the causes that you cared for during your lifetime. The process often starts with involving your loved ones in the decision.

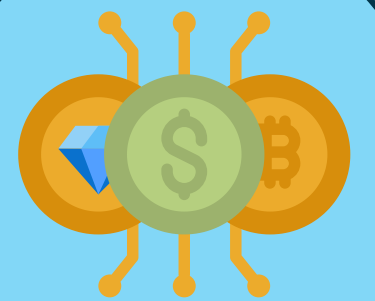
When you're ready to write your will, we recommend meeting with a legal professional to ensure your wishes are clear and easy for your executor to carry out.

Leaving a specific gift

You may choose to donate a specific amount of money or specific assets, such as publicly traded securities, to The Institute for Freedom and Justice.

Here's an example of the wording you could use in your will:

"I give to the Institute for Freedom and Justice, charitable registration number 85481 6162 RR0001, the sum of \$_____, to be used at the discretion of the organization."



Leaving a residual gift



One way to ensure that all remaining property passes to your chosen beneficiaries, is to leave the residue of your estate to The Institute for Freedom and Justice after all other gifts have been made to your loved ones, and any bills or taxes have been paid. A residual gift can be either a percentage of what is left of your estate, or the full amount remaining.

Here's an example of the wording you could use in your will:

"I give to The Institute for Freedom and Justice, charitable registration number 85481 6162 RR0001, _____% of the residue of my estate, to be used at the discretion of the organization."
